


<u>Investment in VT Companies Sees 500 Percent Increase in 2021</u>

Investment in Vermont companies soared nearly 500 percent last year, mostly due to massive capital infusions at the electric-aviation company Beta Technologies and Williston-based Polly, formerly known as DealerPolicy. The year-over-year percentage increase is the largest in the country, said Cairn Cross, co-founder of FreshTracks Capital. Nine of the 38 deals last year were with companies based outside Chittenden County, he said.
